


Driving / Parking

47 Rodney Street is conveniently located close to Liverpool City Centre with pay and display parking to Rodney Street and the surrounding streets, together with parking within the Anglican Cathedral car park accessed at the junction of Rodney Street and Upper Duke Street. Rodney Street is accessed off from the A5058 Edge Lane, following the signs for the Universities and Cathedrals/Philharmonic Hall. Rodney Street basically runs between the Catholic and Anglican Cathedrals. M62 leads directly onto Edge Lane at the Rocket junction.

On Rodney Street, proceed past the first cross roads (Leece Street/Rodney Street) heading towards the Anglican Cathedral and 47 Rodney Street is located on the left hand side just before Mount Street/Knight Street.

As you proceed along Rodney Street, there is pay and display parking on Rodney Street and at the end of Rodney Street you come to the Anglican Cathedral which you cross over Upper Duke Street and follow the road around to the barrier to the car park where there is a ticket machine and then follow the service road around to the main parking area. Leave the car park by the main black gates and then walk back along Rodney Street to 47. On exiting the car park, there are two pay machines which accept cash and card. The ticket is then scanned at the exit barrier to exit the car park.



Public Transport

47 Rodney Street is approximately ten to fifteen minutes walk from Lime Street Station. The taxi rank is to the left hand side when looking at the main exit from inside the station. If walking, upon leaving station via the main front doors, turn left and walk along Lime Street. Continue onto Renshaw Street and follow this road until you come to Leece Street (you will see a Sainsburys and Zorbas Greek Restaurant), veer left up to the traffic lights at which point you turn left and proceed along Rodney Street to 47. The main bus station is located by Liverpool One Shopping off The Strand at the end of Duke Street



We have a small secure yard area available for safe keeping of bicycles.



Disabled access/facilities
